How can a grant-giving charity help?

A grant-giving charity could provide you with a free, non-repayable grant towards daily living costs, essential items and more if you are in need of support.

What are grants given for?

Grants are awarded for all kinds of reasons, and each application is judged case-by-case, but some common examples are to help pay for:

- Daily essentials, including food and clothes
- Bills
- New or replacement furniture and white goods
- Disability adaptations
- Respite breaks
- Childcare and school costs
- Debt and insolvency fees
- Funeral costs

Who can charities help?

There are hundreds of grant-giving charities in the UK, each helping a different group and their families.

There are charities helping those that have ever worked in certain jobs, regional charities, charities supporting those who have a certain illness/disability and more.

What is the application process like?

Although it varies depending on the charity, most will ask you to fill out a short application form and submit a few pieces of evidence requested by the charity to show you need their support.

If you need help with your application, giving one of their friendly team a call or email will often help reassure you as they can support and guide you on their application process.



How do I find a grant?
